SANDY POND SPORTSMENS ASSOCIATION NEW MEMBER APPLICATION ADDENDUM

Welcome perspective new member. Before sending or turning in your application the Board of Directors (BOD) would like for you to review and sign this document.

Listed below is an outline of some of the SPSA policies.

The SPSA is a private club, membership is a privilege, not a right. Once your application and the addendum are signed & returned to the SPSA, the BOD will review the application at the next scheduled meeting. Please note if your hand writing is not legible it will not be acted on. Once reviewed by the BOD the application will go to the General Membership for a vote, at the regularly scheduled meeting. If the applicant is accepted, the BOD will notify the new member. New membership dues are payable within 30 days of your approved membership. If dues are not paid within this time limit you must reapply for membership.

With this membership comes responsibility. The club is only as good as the members make it. SPSA has many outreach programs, social events, and volunteer days. We ask all new members to participate. If you bring in a non-member you must sign them in and they must leave when you leave or be signed in by another member present. You as a member are responsible for your guests and they should be informed of the rules as stated above.

While in the social quarters (upstairs or downstairs) we ask that you refrain from foul language, limit your consumption to levels you can handle. The bartenders are the BOSS. If you are asked to refrain from foul language or if the bartender suggests that you may have had enough to drink, DO NOT confront or argue with the bartender. If you truly believe you have been mistreated, you need to bring this to the attention of the BOD for their review and action if necessary.

Your membership can be suspended or revoked. If there is an issue with a member, in the club or on the club property to the point where someone is offended by the actions of another member, the BOD will review. Both sides will have the opportunity to explain or defend their actions. If the BOD deems it necessary a letter of suspension or revocation will be sent to the member.

This document is only included to inform you of what is to be expected as a member of the SPSA. For additional information, we welcome you to join us for the meetings on the 2nd Sunday of the each month at 12:00PM.
